Getting Started

- Take a look at the Submission Guidelines.
 - Entries should be in the form of an essay, short story, or poem (including a spoken word or written version of a rap) that reflects on cultural identity and diversity.
 - One entry per student.
 - Your submission must be an original work.
- Your English teacher must submit your work. See your English teacher with questions.
- Remember to use standard formatting (no images, introductions, special fonts, etc.).
- The judging panel will evaluate each submission only knowing grade and entry type.
- All questions should be directed to mosaic@folmc.org.

Eligibility

- You must be enrolled in an MCPS middle school that has declared participation in the program.
- You may not be related to FOLMC staff or board members, judges, or administrators.
- By making a submission you and your parents grant FOLMC permission to publish your work in the print anthology and/or on the website.

- Winners and Honorable Mentions are professionally published and added to MCPL collections as well as the collections at each MCPS middle school media center.
- Students with winning/honorable mention entries are invited to present their work at a public ceremony and meet with local authors and professionals in the creative writing and humanities fields.
