Learn about the *Montgomery County* tax law for the Homeowners Property Tax Credit (Form HTC-1) and Renters Tax Credit (Form RTC-1). Leave with your State Form completed and ready to file!

DO YOU QUALIFY?: If you live in **Montgomery County**, and your household income cannot exceed \$60,000 per year and your net worth is less than \$200,000 (not including the value of your home or qualified retirement savings), you could qualify for tax relief on the first \$300,000 of your home's assessed value. If you qualify, the credit could be several hundred dollars, with a maximum credit of the total County tax due on the first \$300,000 of your home's assessed value. If age 70 and older, you may file for the credit three years retroactively and these forms can be either emailed to you or mailed to you.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO APPLY: Copies of your 2018 Federal Tax Return, your 2018 YTD Earnings Document, supporting year end bank statements and copy of your social security card – all copies please.
