English 6	
Unit 2: You and Me How do relationships shape us?	Since the genre focus for this unit is poetry and the theme explores how relationships shape us, look for opportunities for students to experiment with writing their own poems on how their lives have been shaped by relationships in their lives.
Blast: Out of Sorts How has the coronavirus changed your role at home?	This blast is accessible from the StudySync Library and provides students with an opportunity to reflect on how their lives have been impacted by the coronavirus. It could serve as an introduction to student writing that could then be turned into a Mosaic submission for 2021-2022.
Unit 2: You and Me How do relationships shape us?	Extended Writing Project: Can relationships shape your future? Think about the ways in which relationships have shaped the lives of the characters, speakers, or authors. Then reflect on your own life. Think of a person who has influenced you in some way. Would your life be different if this person were not in your life? Do you think relationships can truly shape people's futures? Why or why not?

Unit 2: Highs and Lows What do we learn from love and loss?	Since the genre focus for this unit is poetry and the theme explores lessons learned from love and loss, look for opportunities for students to experiment with writing their own poems about how their lives have been shaped by lessons they have learned from the highs and lows in their life.
Blast: Out of Sorts How has the coronavirus changed your role at home?	This blast is accessible from the StudySync Library and provides students with an opportunity to reflect on how their lives have been impacted by the coronavirus. It could serve as an introduction to student writing that could then be turned into a Mosaic submission for 2021-2022.

Unit 2: Past and Present What makes you, you?	Since the genre focus for this unit is poetry and the theme examines ideas related to identity and community, look for opportunities for students to experiment with writing their own poems that reveal the factors that influence or shape their identity.
