Friends of the Library, Montgomery County (FOLMC) accepts book donations within the following guidelines:

- In good, clean condition
- All languages
- All textbooks
- We especially appreciate:
 - Antiquarian materials
 - Large print books
 - Spanish language books
 - Children's books

Items we cannot accept:

- Books in unsalable condition: soiled, water damaged, broken or cracked spines, missing pages, strong odors
- General Encyclopedias (e.g., Britannica, World Book)
- Condensed books (e.g., Reader's Digest)
- National Geographic Magazine
- Books on Tape

FOLMC also accepts other types of gently used media such as:

- Magazines (12 months old or newer only)
- Music in any format, to include CDs, Vinyl records, and Cassette tapes
- Blu-Ray, DVD, and Laserdisc
- Video games
- Comics and graphic novels
- Children's toys, games, and puzzles
- Board and Card Games for all ages (must have all the pieces)
